Learning Services

Children's Hospital Colorado's Learning Specialists, in the Department of Audiology, Speech Pathology and Learning Services, conduct comprehensive learning evaluations and provide learning support services and therapies to individuals as well as small groups of children. Specialists provide children and families access to the most current knowledge and advancements in the fields of learning and learning disabilities. The diagnostic learning evaluations provide families, professionals and caregivers with comprehensive information related to the child's academic strengths and needs. Parents are provided with information and guidance to help them ensure that their child's academic needs are adequately addressed. Together, these learning specialists provide support and a circle of family-centered care unmatched in the Rocky Mountain/Great Plains region.

Staff

All Learning Service programs are staffed by professionals with advanced degrees and specialty training in education, learning disabilities, dyslexia, overall academics, and child development. All Learning Specialists are certified by national professional organizations or state certification bodies.

Outpatient Learning Services

The Learning Services program provides diagnostic learning evaluations and learning therapy services for children and adolescents suspected of having a learning disability or having overall difficulty in school. Evaluations and therapy are **offered in both English and Spanish**.

- Diagnostic evaluations for dyslexia, learning disabilities and other specific learning needs
- Individualized evidence-based, multi-sensory learning therapies designed to address specific needs in the development of reading or written language
- Small group programs for students with reading disorders such as dyslexia
 - Intensive interventions offered throughout the year
 - Summer specialty intensive programs to develop pre-literacy and literacy skills
- Workshops/presentations designed to expand the knowledge of professionals who work with children with language-based learning disabilities such as dyslexia
- Teletherapy delivered by a learning specialist using evidence-based, multi-sensory therapies.

Inpatient School Program

The inpatient school program provides school services without charge to school aged children who are hospitalized for two weeks or more. School services are made available on all Children's Hospital Colorado medical units.

- Consultation with families
- Consultation with a child's home-school during and after hospitalization
- Educational instruction provided as a child's health and hospital schedule permit
